## LABOR DAY PARADE UPDATE

Due to insufficient response, the Detroit District Area Local will not be able to provide a float at this year's Labor Day Parade. However, the Local will be marching and all members are urged to come downtown to show their solidarity on this special day for the labor movement. Event shirts will be provide at the marshalling site for those who called to RSVP and gave their shirt size. We will be bringing our picket signs for all marchers to carry.

All members, family and friends are urged to attend. As always, wagons, buggies and bicycles are allowed. This year, our mashalling area is in the same location that it has been for several past years, **Michigan Avenue between Rosa Parks Boulevard and Vermont.** For those who don't know the neighborhood, this is about four blocks to the west of where old Tiger Stadium used to stand. All postal unions are marshalling in this area.

Parking is available on side streets in the area, but Michigan Avenue itself will be blocked off from early in the morning so you must approach from side streets.

At present, we plan to have shuttling available from the end of the route back to the marshalling area. This may involve waiting depending on how many need shuttling.

**Step off time is announced at 9:30am. Staging begins at 7:00am.**
