Due to the recent resignation of “the DETROIT POSTAL WORKER” associate editor, Danny Sawicki, President Keith Combs is seeking interested members willing to take on the position of associate editor of our local union newspaper.

The associate editor is an appointed position as defined in our Local Constitution. The Associate Editor is responsible for the managing and editing of all materials submitted by officers or members of the APWU for publication in the Detroit Postal Worker. The Detroit Postal Worker is published at least once per postal quarter. The Associate Editor shall determine the content and layout for the paper and supervise the printing.

The Associate Editor shall maintain membership in the APWU National Postal Press Association and shall attend the APWU National Postal Press Association’s Editors Conference held bi-annually. The Associate Editor shall receive a salary of \$600.00 per year, plus be paid lost time and expenses as approved by the president. They shall also receive \$50.00 for each general membership meeting they attend, to be paid annually.
