ALL members (**PSEs included**) in good standing of the Detroit Local are eligible to be stewards. **NO MINIMUM YEARS OF SERVICE ARE NECESSARY.** Stewards are the front line of the union on the workfloor, enforcing the contract and defending their co-workers from management abuse.

Think you might be steward material? Stewards must:

-Have excellent attendance. Stewards must first be good examples as employees.

-Be willing to stand up to management and take strong positions on the workfloor.

-Be willing to constantly upgrade their knowledge of the National Agreement and the many USPS handbooks, manuals and regulations.

-Be willing to research and write up grievances.

-Attend all required union training and craft meetings, which may be on your own time.

-Attend all monthly general membership meetings, which are on your own time/leave.

-Take union positions on the workfloor, as established by the President or craft officers.

-Devote unpaid time to union activities, training and meetings. Being a steward is not a money-making pursuit; it is a calling.

If you think this might be for you, send a written request to the attention of the President of this local at the above address, with a copy to the attention of your craft director. Give your name, address, phone number and work installation/tour. Tell us why you want to be a steward. If you are willing to help, WE NEED YOU!!
